The MOU will facilitate a "soft start" approach where a GSA will be formed initially with the basic powers and authorities as allowed under the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA). Once formed, the GSA will then circle back with more detailed governance discussions.

5. Stanislaus County Programmatic Environmental Impact Report (PEIR) – Modeling Plan Review

Mike Tietze from Jacobson James and Associates provided a status report related to the PEIR for Implementation of Stanislaus County Groundwater Ordinance. In the coming months, JJ&A will be developing the draft Modeling Plan, preparing an Initial Study and
