Enas advised group that only two STRGBA GSA agencies have submitted the groundwater data requested by Todd Groundwater. The due date is October 31, 2018. willing to help with outreach efforts such as preparing flyers, and posting information on the website, Facebook, etc.

5. USGS Monitoring Wells Maps

Alvarez distributed maps showing the locations of monitoring wells installed by USGS around 2004 throughout the City of Modesto. The purpose for the wells was to develop a robust transient optimization model of the Modesto Sub-basin. The group discussed the installation of additional monitoring wells and agreed that the biggest need is to install more wells on the eastside of the Sub-basin rather than within the City limits.

6. Cost Sharing Agreement

Alvarez reported that most of the GSA agencies have signed the cost sharing agreement and that he should be able to send out a fully executed copy of the agreement along with invoices in next few weeks.

7. DWR Kickoff Meeting

The group discussed Todd Groundwater's work plan. Alvarez stated he will contact Todd to ensure their scope of work includes a Final GSP. The scope of work currently includes only a "draft" GSP as the final deliverable.
